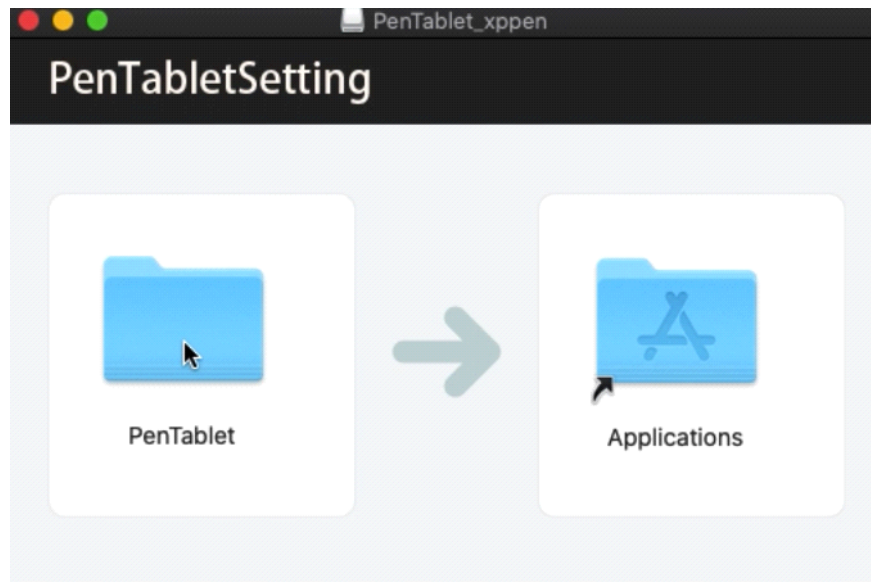
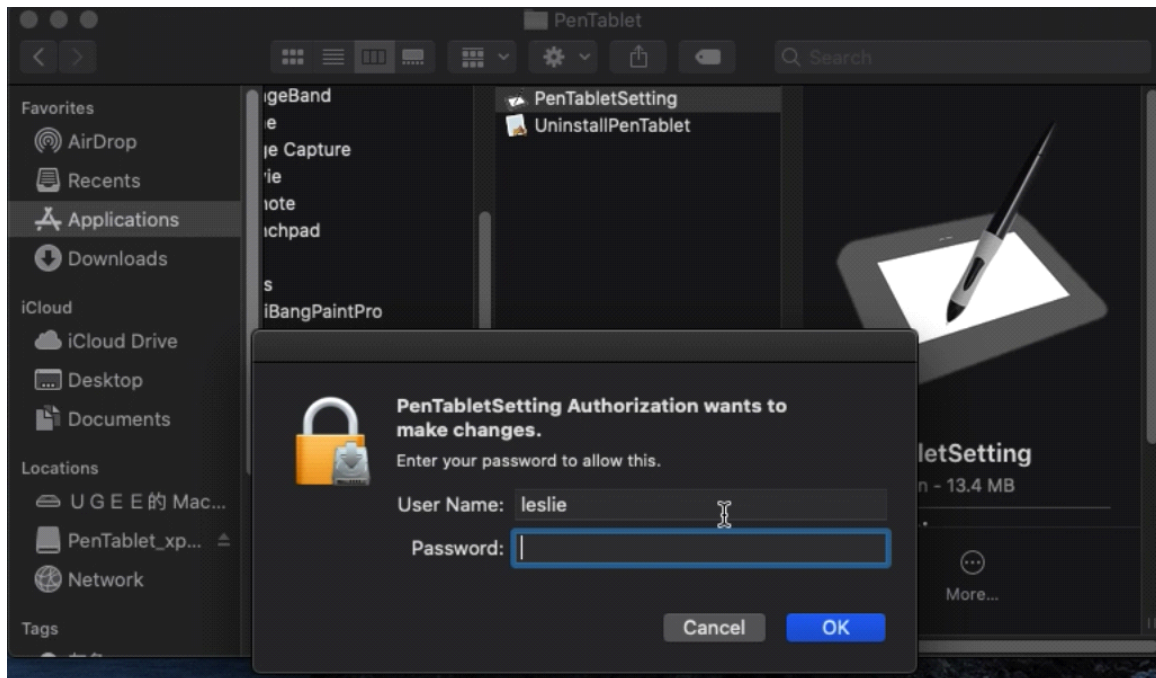


How to instal XP-Pen driver on Catalina (10.15)

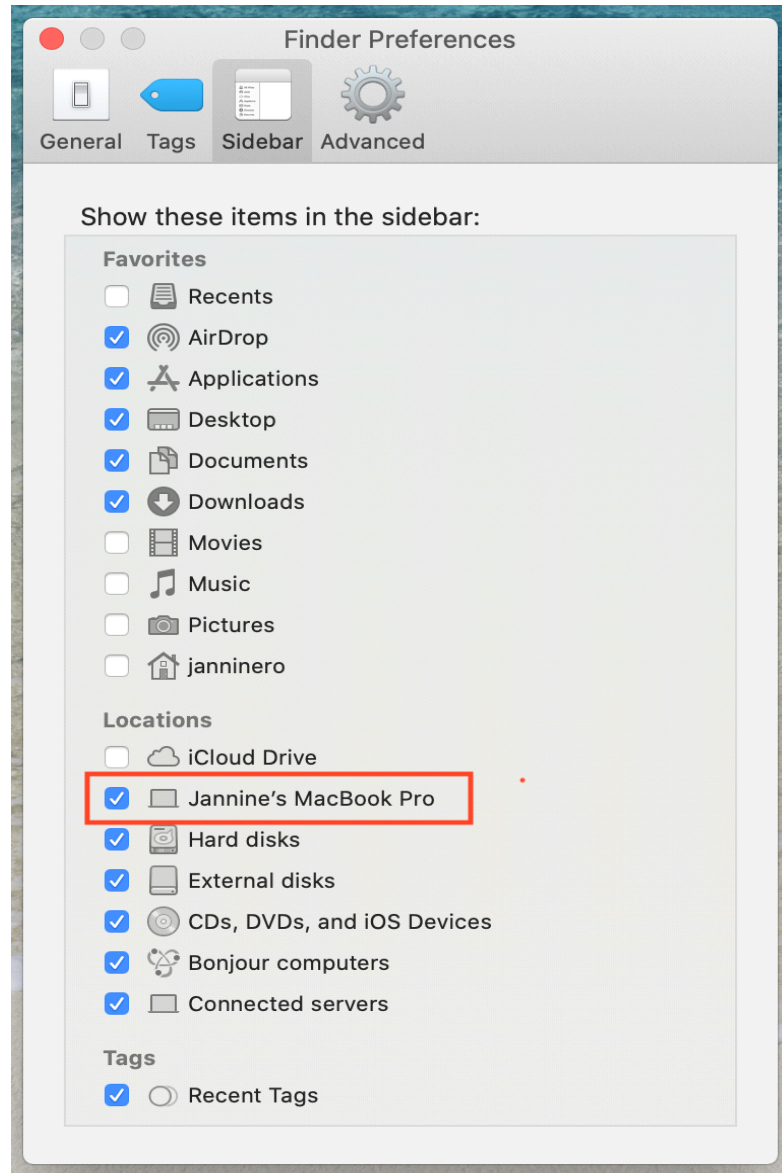
- Go to the Application Folder and make sure to uninstall any previous tablet drivers and then restart your computer.
- After the restart, please go to the XP-Pen official website then download and install the newest Mac driver.
- *When the window below pops, drag the “PenTablet” folder to the Applications folder.*



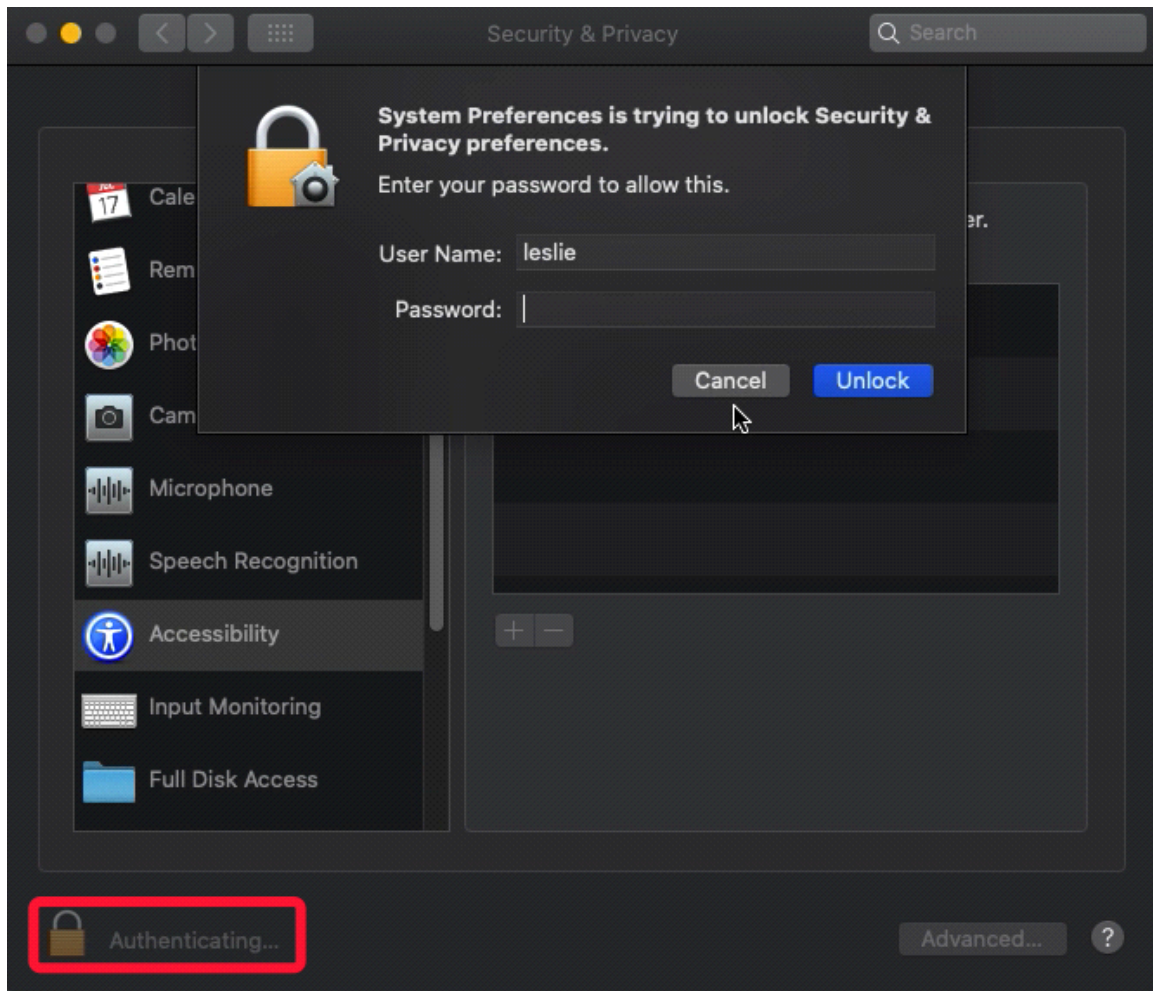
- The driver install is now complete. Next, please go to “Applications” -> “PenTablet” folder and run *PenTabletSetting*, type in your password in needed.



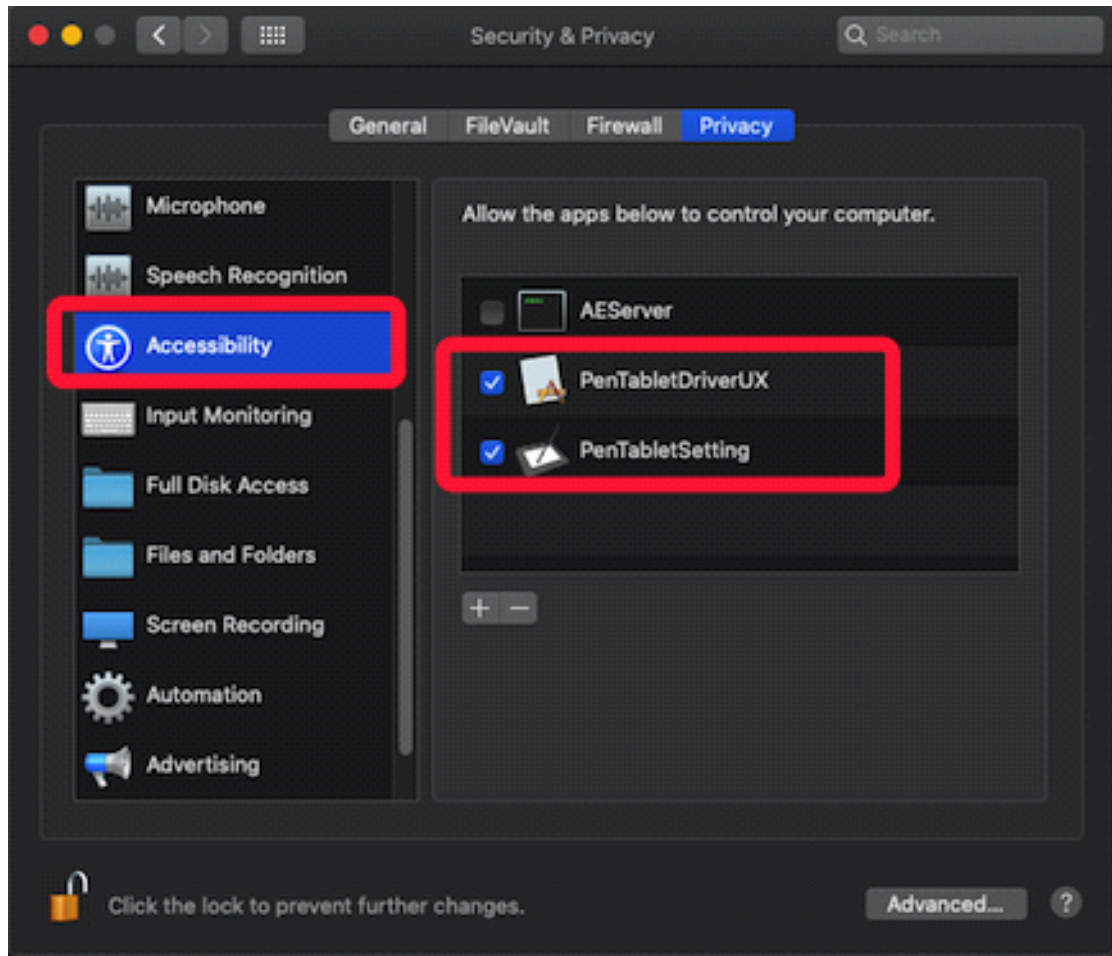
- Next, go to ***“Finder”-> “Preferences” -> “Sidebar”***.
- On the ***“Sidebar”*** tab, please make sure the box next to your computer's name is checked like in the image below.



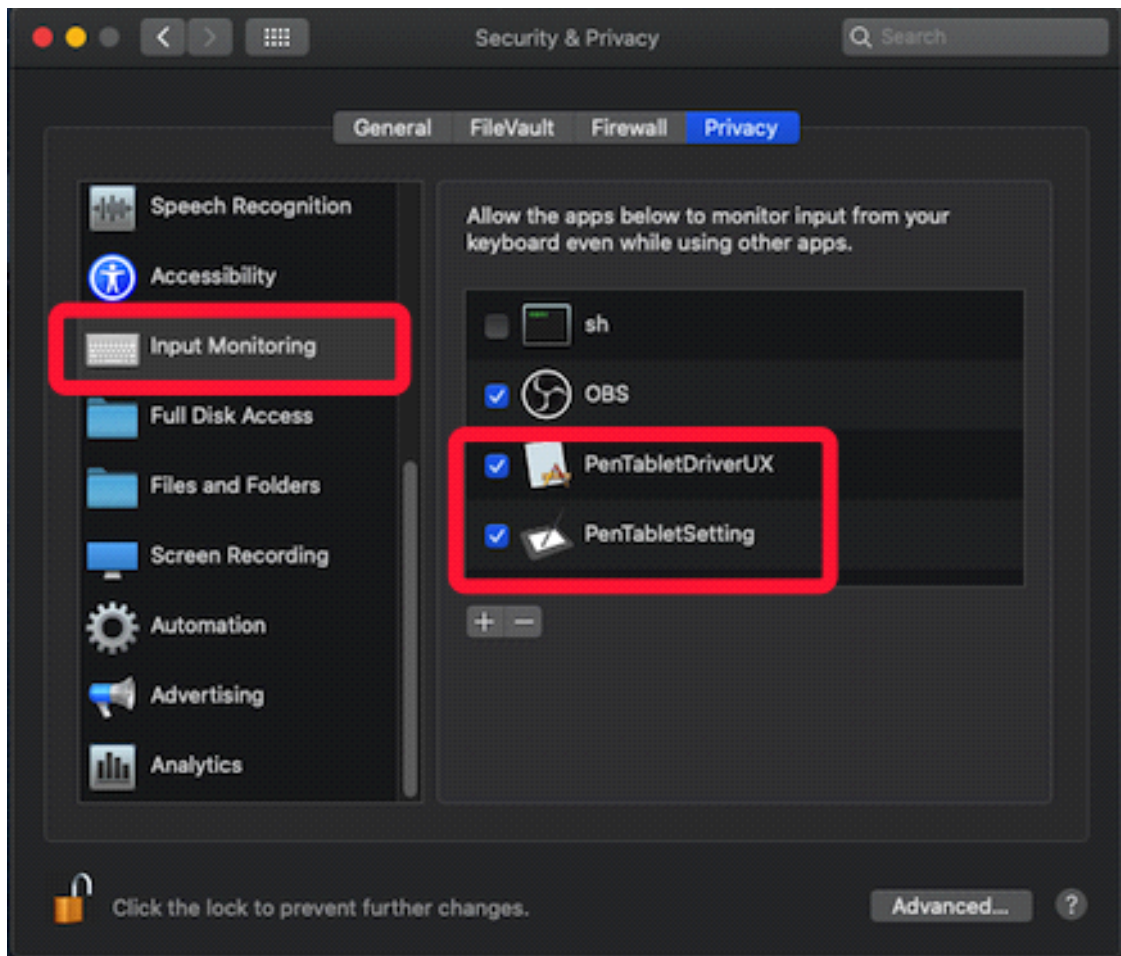
- Now, go to *"System Preferences"* -> *"Security & Privacy"*.
- On the Privacy Tab, click on the *"Lock"* icon, and type in your password if needed.



- On the "*Accessibility*" tab, please enable "*PenTabletSetting*".
- Click "+" button then go to "*Hard Drive*" -> "*Library*" -> "*Application Support*" -> "*PenTablet*" folder. Click on "*PenTabletDriverUX*" and click OK.



- Go to *Input Monitor tab* and please also enable “*PenTabletSetting*”.
- Click “+” button then go to “*Hard Drive*”-> “*Library*” -> “*Application Support*” -> “*PenTablet*” folder, click on “*PenTabletDriverUX*” and click OK.
(If you get error message, just click “Quit Now”)



- *Restart your Mac and after that please open the PenTablet setting then check for pen pressure.*
